

Items Required for Camp Camp MERC 2011

This is a checklist to help you and child get ready with all items required at camp. Your child should be aware of what and how everything is packed, as they will be expected to look after their own belongings while we are away.

Sleeping Gear:

Pillow, pillow case, sleeping bag, sheet to cover mattress

Footwear:

Old shoes (*suitable for water activities*)

Boat shoes for kayaking (*optional*)

Sneakers (*suitable for bush activities*)

Sandals

Socks

Clothing:

Underwear (*several changes*)

Shorts

T-Shirts

Warm shirts

Sweatshirts

Long pants/track pants

Togs and towel for swimming

Raincoat

Pyjamas

Handkerchiefs or tissues

Hat

Toilet Gear:

Sunblock, lipscreen, Insect repellent, toothbrush & tooth paste, hairbrush, hair ties, soap, shampoo, flannel, towel for showering.

Dining Utensils:

3 tea towels

2 plates (Flat and bowl)

Cup

Knife, fork, spoon

Drink bottle

Also:

Day pack for day trips

Clothes pegs

Torch

Book for recreational reading

Plastic bags for dirty clothes

Camera (Optional - *Disposable only*)

Snack Box:

A sealable container of nutritious snacks to supplement morning, afternoon tea and lunch. **NO NUTS! (Not Necessary)**

Packed Lunch:

Morning tea and lunch for Wednesday

All items must be clearly **named** and **appropriate** for camp activities. Children are responsible for their own property.

All medications must be clearly labelled, in a plastic bag and handed to Linda Lilburne & Jim Kriechbaum on Monday morning!!

NOT PERMITTED:

Money, jewellery, cellphones, walkmans, gameboys, portable music players, or any electronic items.
